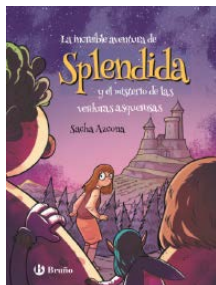

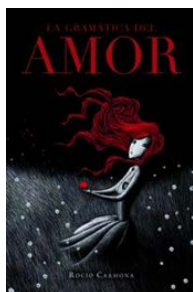

teacher, a silent suitor secretly aspire to her heart. But before making a decision, Irene will have to learn the seven secrets of the grammar of love...

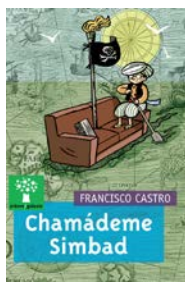
